2025-2026 Bus Pass Application:

Families of students who are eligible for school bus transportation based on walk limits – or who require accessible (special needs) bussing – must submit a bus pass application for the 2025-2026 school year. Students living on reserve do not need to apply.

The link to bus pass application can be found on the Carihi website or SD72 Transportation website.

You must have a valid bus pass to ride next year so please be sure to apply early so that you receive your new bus pass in September.

Those that are currently under 'courtesy ridership' will need to reapply for this with the office, after September 30th. Courtesy ridership is only approved if there is space remaining on a route after all eligible students have been assigned and is granted on first come, first serve basis.

Yearbooks:

If you ordered a yearbook, you can pick it up today through Friday in front of the office at lunch.

Yearbooks must be picked up at lunch time only - they are not available before or after school, or during class time. Grads, your yearbooks will be moved with your cap & gowns after lunch time today if you have yet to pick up your books!
