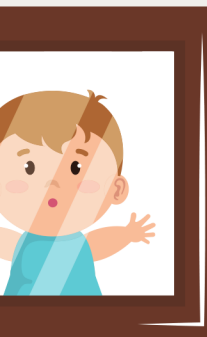

What is the “Tyee Transition Package”?

Your “Tyee Transition Package” is a reflective workbook to help you think about some of the important aspects of your life as you transition to life beyond high school. This booklet is one part of your Career Life Connections (CLC 12) credits that must be earned in order to graduate!



A powerful myth seems to exist that all students should know exactly what they want to do with the rest of their lives by the time they leave school. For some people this may be the case, but for most students the journey will look very different. It will certainly not be linear! Is one path more successful than another? Absolutely not! This is because every individual is different and thankfully so. Otherwise, the world would be a very boring place. Therefore what “Success” means to one person is completely different than what it may mean to someone else.
