Work Experience

Are you currently working or volunteering or will be getting a job and you'll be in Grade 11 or 12 in Sept 2025?

Would you like to get high school credits for the skills you are gaining in the workplace?

The Work Experience Program (WEX) gives students in Gr 11 or 12 the opportunity to:

- participate in, observe, and learn about the tasks and responsibilities related to a career or occupation
- count as credits toward graduation



Students must:

- attend a WEX workshop on May 29 (4 options to accommodate classes) work hours are counted after the initial paperwork is completed
- complete a 100+ hours from start date to end of school
- finish assignments & paperwork by the due dates

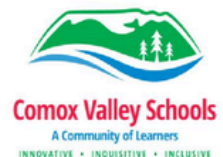

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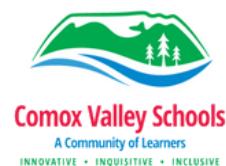
