Carihi Secondary Prom Permission Form 2023

Prom will take place on **Saturday**, **June 17**th with two separate events. The Foreshore gathering for grads, friends, family and staff takes place from 4:00 – 5:30pm and Prom is from 5:45 – 12:30am. Each celebration, the Foreshore gathering and Prom, is a **school event** and all students are expected to abide by the **Code of Conduct** in order to ensure that our prom is a safe, fun event. Please review the code of conduct and expectations below with your child.

- Our Prom event starts at the foreshore (Robert Osler Park) any time after 4:00pm on June 17th. Friends and family may gather with our grads to take photos. This is also an opportunity for staff to congratulate our graduates.
- Reminder: With 185 grads and their families gathering, there will be limited parking at Robert Osler Park and you may need to park further downtown and walk in to the site.
- We ask that all grads be at the park by 4:00pm. At 4:30 pm we will gather grads at the south end of the gravel pathway, close to the Quay restaurant. At that time, they will take a short walk down the path with a friend or two, with family and friends lined up at either side cheering and applauding all the grads.
- Upon arrival at the other end, they will be organized into a group for a Grad 2023 photo.
- After the photo, there will be an opportunity for the grads to have a special dance with a family member
- All grads should depart the foreshore by 5:30 p.m. and head to the lower parking lot entrance of our school. Doors for the prom will be open at 5:45 and close at 6:15
- Families are responsible for transporting grads to and from Prom. No grad should drive themselves to the event and must be accompanied by a responsible adult. Grads who need a ride to Prom, please see Mr. McLaughlin or Mr. Hopkins-Bogle. Sharing rides is permitted if the driver is the parent of one of the grads.
- Upon entering, grads may be searched. If they are found to have banned substances, and/or are under/suspected to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol, they will be denied entry to prom. This is a no smoking event, which includes vaping and e-cigarettes.
- At the end of the event grads must be picked up by a member of their family or other responsible adult from the lower parking lot. Administrators will be coordinating this process. Grads may choose to leave Prom at any point but once grads leave the event they cannot re-enter. Grads must sign out with the adult driving them home.
- If grads fail to comply with school and prom regulations, they will be asked to leave the prom and may lose the privilege to participate in commencement on June 28th and may be subject to a school suspension.

The bottom of this form is to be completed and brought to the main office by the student prior to purchasing tickets.

Grads will not be allowed to attend Prom without a signed form.
