

The [Student Transcripts Service \(STS\)](#) allows you to view and order secondary school transcripts from B.C. or the Yukon. You may also order secondary school certificates from B.C. See [Help Videos](#) on using the STS.

Order transcripts or certificates as a

- Current student**
 - You are now enrolled in a secondary school, or
 - Have completed a course within the last six months
- Former student**
 - More than six months have passed since you completed a secondary school course
- Returning user**
 - You are familiar with the Student Transcripts Service (STS) and have used it before

Additional services

- Order a General Educational Development (GED®) transcript or certificate**
 - Available if you completed the GED® tests from 1973 to 2014
- Contact your school of record or district office**
 - If you last attended school between 1974-1985, contact your secondary school for your transcript or certificate
- Find your Personal Education Number (PEN)**
 - Not sure if you have a PEN? Find out if you have a PEN and the ways to find it
