Honour Roll at Timberline

To achieve honour roll, students must have an "A" average (86%) calculated using their final marks from semester one and their interim marks from term three. TA blocks and CLC12 are not included in the honour roll calculations.

We have also made a change to the honour roll program this year! The first year that students achieve honour roll they will receive a certificate. The second year, they receive a certificate and a bronze pin, then in third year they receive a certificate and silver pin. Finally, if a student has achieved honour roll for all four years at Timberline, they will receive a certificate and gold pin. We encourage graduating students to wear their pins with their cap and gown when crossing the stage at commencement. For the 2024-2025 school year students will only receive the pin they earn this year and not for previous years.

We recognize our Honour Roll students at a gathering for recipients only in mid-June.

Awards at Timberline

Students are selected for annual awards based on a variety of criteria.

First, there are the "Subject Excellence Awards" which are typically awarded to Grade 12 students who have demonstrated excellence in a course or subject area. Recipients will receive the Grade 12 "Timberline Academic" pin and we encourage them to wear it at commencement. The Grade 9 – 11 students who have achieved the top average marks of their grade will be awarded a "Top Academic" pin.

Grade 9 – 11 students who have demonstrated service and commitment to volunteerism will receive a "Timberline Service" pin, and those who have played a role in promoting and developing school spirit will receive a "Timberline Spirit" pin. In addition, the Athletes of the Year awards will be presented to the Junior and Senior top athletes.

These awards will be given out at the Timberline Awards assembly at the end of June. Students who are receiving awards, and their families, will receive an invitation to the event though all students are encouraged to attend.

Timberline Major Awards

Finally, we have the major awards!

Heart of the Pack is awarded to a grade 12 students who has made an outstanding contribution to the school and greater community. This award is given to a student who is committed to service, and the betterment of their community.

Resilience of the Wolf is awarded to a graduating student who has encountered and overcome challenges throughout their educational journey and demonstrated a determination to keep going even when the path wasn't easy.

Spirit of the Wolf is given to a grade 12 student who has played a major role in promoting and developing school spirit at Timberline. This student embodies school culture and acts as a positive role model to all members of the Timberline community.

Finally, **Wolf of the Year**: This award goes to an outstanding Grade 12 student who distinguishes themselves in all areas of school involvement including academics, citizenship, service, and/or extra-curricular activities.

These awards will be presented on stage at the commencement ceremony where students, family, and friends will be present to recognize the recipients for this distinction.

Please note: All awards may have more than one recipient.
