- Poetry Contest

The theme for this year's poetry contest is Family.

You may enter any of these contests throughout April. The deadline for ALL submissions is Wednesday, April 30th. There will be prizes for the best poem in each category.

All poems must be submitted to Mrs. Parkinson in the LLC. Please fill in an entry form for every poem you are submitting. Typed poems are preferred over handwritten (except for Blackout Poetry).

Contest 1:

Family Snapshot Poem Contest 🛅

Challenge: Write a poem that describes a family moment as if it were a photograph. It could be a real memory or an imagined scene.

Judging Criteria: Vivid imagery, emotion, and creativity.

Contest 2:

Blackout Poetry: Words from the Past

Challenge: Use old book pages or newspapers (both of which Mrs. Parkinson has) to create blackout poetry about family. Students must highlight words to form a poem and black out the rest.

Judging Criteria: Creativity, originality, and how well the poem connects to family.

Contest 3:

Found Family: Poetry About More Than Blood

Challenge: Write a poem about chosen family—friends, mentors, or pets that feel like family. Judging Criteria: Creativity and personal connection.

Contest 4:

Acrostic Family Poetry 😯

Challenge: Write an acrostic poem using the word "FAMILY" (or another related word like "MEMORIES" or "TOGETHER"... see the bulletin board just inside the LLC doors for more word options- they are inside the speech bubbles).

Example:

Finding warmth in laughter's glow Always there, through highs and lows Memories woven tight and strong In every hug, where I belong Love that never fades away Yesterday, today, and always stay Judging Criteria: Creativity and depth.

Contest 5:

Reverse Poetry: Two Sides of Family **6**

Challenge: Write a poem that can be read two ways—top to bottom and bottom to top, revealing different perspectives on family.

Example Topic:

- A sibling rivalry that turns into love.
- A tough family moment that teaches a lesson.

Judging Criteria: Creativity and skill in writing a reversible poem.

Contest 6:

"Dear Future Me" Family Poem 🔀

Challenge: Write a poem as a letter to your future self about what family means to you right now. Judging Criteria: Thoughtfulness and emotional depth.

Contest 7:

Sensory Poetry: A Family Memory 👃 👂 🤥

Challenge: Write a poem about a family moment using all five senses. Example:

The smell of Sunday pancakes

 The sound of Dad's old rock music The warmth of Grandma's hug Judging Criteria: Use of sensory language and vivid descriptions.
