

Installing the Kwakwala (Liqwala) Keyboard

1. Open the EDGE browser. Use the following website address to access the Kwakwala installation file.

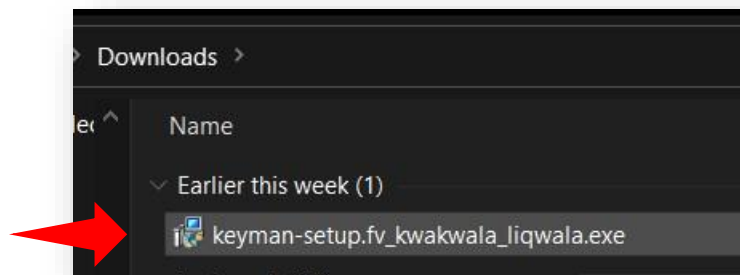
2. Click on the “Install keyboard” icon. (You’ll have to do it twice. The first time brings up a donation message.)



3. Once it is downloaded, double click “Open File” link located in the top right of your screen.



If you don't see it here, you will find it in your “Downloads” folder. Double click on the file.



4. Click “Yes” on the next pop-up window. Click “Install”.



5. The next pop-up that appears, lets you know the keyboard has been installed. Uncheck “Show the screen at start-up” box and click “Exit”.



6. You’ve now installed the keyboard-layout. In the System Tray at the right bottom of your desktop, you will see keyboard language icon “ENG”. You can toggle between the two keyboards as needed by just selecting them from this location.



Once your keyboard is installed and selected, use the below keyboard layout and key combos for the special characters needed.

Notes

- The special characters of K^wak^wala have been assigned to the number keys. To type the numerals, hold down the **Right-Alt** or **Option** key then press the appropriate number key. The Numeric keypad on the right side of many keyboards keep its original numbers.
- Accents are typed after the base character: *ṭ* is typed **t** then **Apostrophe** **'**.
- To type the glottalized accent *ʔ* use the **Apostrophe** key **'**. *ḳ* is typed **k** then **Apostrophe** **'**.
- The English keyboard's punctuation marks can be typed by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option** key. The **Left-Bracket** **[** is typed **Right-Alt+Left-Bracket** (Windows) **Option+Left-Bracket** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
 - single: **'** Left-Bracket — **'** Right-Bracket
 - double: **“** Shift+Left-Bracket — **”** Shift+Right-Bracket
 - single **<** Right-Alt+Shift+9 — **>** Right-Alt+Shift+0
 - double **«** Right-Alt+9 — **»** Right-Alt+0
