UPDATE ON BATTLE OF THE BOOKS 2025-2026 SCHOOL YEAR

Dear Families & Caregivers,

We want to share an update about Battle of the Books at elementary schools for this school year. As some of you may be aware, elementary library programs are being delivered differently. Teacher librarians are now providing prep coverage for classroom teachers, which changes how library time is scheduled and supported. Because of this shift, we will not be running Battle of the Books this year.

We know this news may be disappointing for students who enjoy the program. Battle of the Books has been a valued literacy experience for many years, and we appreciate the excitement it has brought to students and families. Staff will be using this year to explore how the program might continue in the future in a way that is sustainable, including looking at coordination and funding needs.

Battle of the Books will continue in middle schools. Grade 5 students will have the opportunity to participate in Battle of the Books when they enter middle school next year. Our commitment to literacy remains strong. Students will continue to be supported through classroom learning and library programs that promote reading, inquiry, and a love of books.
