2. To complete your requests please choose **Electives** from the grade 11 and 12 courses in the course booklet and list them in order of preference. **To graduate, at least 3 of your courses, in addition to English Studies 12 must be at the grade 12 level.**
3. **Don't forget to list any missing grade 10 or 11 courses (English, Math, Science, Social Studies, PE) that you will need to complete in grade 12.**
4. Choosing any out of timetable courses does not count towards your 8 total courses.
