Upcoming Safety Drills:

Hold and Secure Drill on November 5. Used when there is a threat or potential threat of violence OUTSIDE the school. The exterior doors are locked, people stay away from windows and no one is allowed in or out until all clear is called.

Lock Down Drill on November 18 morning. Used when there is a threat of violence INSIDE the school. When this occurs, everyone retreats to the closest lock down zone.

- Doors locked, lights off
- Everyone is quiet and out of sight
- No one is allowed in or out until all clear is called by principal or police.
