While we try to keep schools open on every instructional day, there may be times when schools must close due to extreme weather, particularly heavy snowfalls. Our default is always to try to keep schools open if possible, except for when our school buses may not be able to safely run and there are serious safety risks for students travelling to and from school.

Parents, students and school district staff will be informed when schools are closed through the school district's website, their school website, <u>Facebook</u>, <u>Instagram</u>, <u>X/Twitter</u> by 7 a.m. at the latest. Those who have downloaded and enabled notifications from the district's <u>parent portal app</u> will get a notice to their cell phone as soon as the message is posted to our websites.

When all schools across the district are closed, or if power outages prevent us from posting a closure notice, the local media will be notified. If there is no announcement on the school website/social media, listen to one of the local radio stations:

99.7 FM - The River

97.3 FM - The Eagle

98.9 FM - The Jet

No announcements by 7:00 a.m. means schools are open and operating as usual.

Even if schools are open, we respect and support parents if you feel that it is unsafe to send your child to school or wish to pick-up your child early due to potentially unsafe weather conditions. If you choose to keep your child home, please report your child's absence through the school's attendance line.

2025-2026 Kindergarten Registration

If your child is turning 5 in 2025 it's time to register for kindergarten! Kindergarten registration week will begin February 3, 2025 and continue until the end of the week on February 7. Register by May 12, 2025 to secure your space in your neighborhood school. When you register either online or at one of our school offices, you will need to provide copies of the following identification documents to satisfy proof of age, address, etc:

- Child's birth certificate (Canadian) or proof of citizenship;
- Child's Care Card;
- Proof of current residence (hydro bill, completed purchase/rental agreement, or property tax notice/assessment); and
- Custody agreement, if applicable.

The school office may require you to verify documents by presenting the originals at a later time. Please provide an accurate email address and phone number for parent/guardian contact.

Complete the online PDF fillable form and drop it off at your neighborhood catchment school. If you don't have printer access, you can register in person at the school office.


