## More details:

- **1) Entrance and Ticket Sales**-*Please note that the entrance fee to the event is a donation for the food hamper!* However, the cost for tickets to be used at most of the stations will be 10 tickets for \$5.00.
  - Also, we will need a few people to help out with ticket sales.
- 2) **Chinese Auction**—*Donation items are needed!* Please think of an item you can donate or have donated by a business that you frequent. Some examples are: gift certificates for services, framed pictures, jewelry, household items, etc.... Please drop off your donation to the school office!
  - Aren Knudsen has volunteered to organize the Chinese Auction, but we will need more volunteers to take shifts at this station (collecting money and handing out tickets, etc...).
- 3) **Vendor's Market-**This year, we will be having a vendor's market at the event. The Ocean Grove community is invited to promote their business and sell goods for the cost of \$10.00/table and a donation to the Chinese Auction. - 4) **Concession-** We need a few volunteers to help with serving the food and drinks at the concession. We especially need a volunteer to buy the supplies for the concession and prepare the food prior to the event.
- 5) **Craft Room helpers** We will be setting up a few Christmas crafts for children to do. Tara Idiens will be coordinating this station but we will need some additional volunteers in the craft room to help out.
- 6) **Bake Sale** Leslie Stevens will be coordinating the Bake Sale. *Baked goods wanted!* We would appreciate any baking you can contribute to be sold at our bake sale. This is always a popular part of the event so the more, the better!

  Also, we will need a few parent volunteers to help with sales.
- 7) Cake Walk- Jo Dumont and Leslie Stevens will be overseeing the cake walk and would appreciate some helpers.
  We also need cakes! We can actually call this a "bake walk," as in the past we have added cookie-trees and other seasonal-looking baked items as prizes. Be creative! Kids (and adults) love this event!
