## **Principals Report to P.A.C. for November**

November 18, 2024

### **Reflections:**

We are officially past the mid-way mark for our first semester and term one report cards are scheduled to go home tomorrow. When meeting with Student Advisory today, every student said they are happy to be in the semester system. This is a small subsection of the student body, and more feedback from students is needed.
