## 2021 PAC Budget

Louise will look over the budget from previous years and re-evaluate compared to other school monies available. In 2020/2021 the budget was adjusted to reflect Covid needs, so these numbers may require refiguring. Cheryl will contact department teachers to discuss their needs. A new draft budget will be put together to vote on.

If there are extra monies available, PAC may put the offer out to all teachers to request additional support. Louise mentioned the need for a student "hang out" area that funds could go towards. This can be discussed later.

#### **Bursary Money**

>2021 Grads - pictures were presented of the 9 students who received awards this year and which awards they won. Of the 9, only 1 has shown proof that they will be attending post-secondary this year. 1 other student has responded that their school receipts are still being processed and another student asked for an extension.

\*Cheryl motioned to extend the 2021 bursary distribution for 2 years due to covid restrictions and some students needing to postpone their post-secondary education. Jerry seconded. All in favor.

>2020 Grads - Only 3 out of 9 bursary recipients have claimed their bursary. A notice was sent out to inform the graduates that they have a 2-year extension due to possible covid issues causing a delay in their post-secondary education. We received a request from Franko Pellegrin, asking to use his bursary in 2023 after his apprenticeship. \*Cheryl motioned to set aside Franko Pellegrin's bursary money until 2023 when he will attend in-class post-secondary education. Nicole seconded. All in favor.

>2019 Grads- 5 out of 9 graduates have claimed their bursaries.
