- These bursaries are based on your program, your essay and your letter(s) of recommendation. Rotary is a Service Club so if you have any volunteer service please include it in your application. *The requested transcript provides the committee with a sense of course choices / commitment to school.*
- If you are shortlisted for a bursary you must attend an in-person interview with members of the Daybreak Rotary Scholarship/Bursary Committee.
- All students are also invited to apply for a Daybreak Rotary Service Scholarship as well, see your counselor for more information.
- **Applications must be completed by 2:00 p.m. APRIL 13th, 2026 to be picked up from the school's counselling center.**
