All students who are eligible to graduate from a Campbell River area secondary school in 2026 are encouraged to apply if they are expecting to attend a post-secondary institution. This may be a vocational school, university, college or other form of post-secondary education.

Please note that these awards are based primarily on the Rotary principle of 'Service Above Self.' The requested transcript provides the committee with a list of course choices and students' commitment to their education.

Letters of recommendation may also note the applicant's service activities.

This is not a scholarship that rewards perfect performance in academics. Service is more highly valued than marks. There are two major scholarships and multiple smaller scholarships available. The major scholarships are described below.

Major Scholarship Descriptions

Community Service Excellence Scholarship

The winner of the Community Service Excellence Scholarship will be a student whose volunteer work in Campbell River has made an appreciable difference. Service Above Self Scholarship
