

## **2024 BURSARY APPLICATION**

LOCAL 723 of the Canadian Union of Public Employees is offering four (4) bursaries of \$750.00 each to students who are graduating from a School District 72 (Campbell River) Senior Secondary School (2024), who are dependents of a LOCAL 723 member, and who plan to attend a post-secondary institution in September of 2024. One (1) graduating from Carihi Secondary School, one (1) graduating from Robron Centre, one (1) graduating from Timberline Secondary School, and one (1) Indigenous Graduate.

Each of the four awards will be made based on NEED, academic achievement, and previous work, volunteer, and community service history. Monies will be distributed to the successful applicant upon presentation of proof of registration at a post-secondary institution. The Bursary Committee may consider delaying an award to a successful applicant if such applicant is prevented from entering a post-secondary institution in September for reasons beyond their control.

The CUPE Local 723 Bursary Committee reserves the right to withhold the award(s) in any year where no applicants meet the Bursary Guideline Criteria.
