Supervision Before & After School:

In the morning, we have two adults circling the building and scanning the playground to try and maintain everyone's safety. After school, our supervisors are at the front of the building keeping our bus students safe. Please try and have your child(ren) arrive as close to the bell in the morning. Thank you!

Water Bottles & Masks:

Unfortunately, due to the COVID protocols we have in place, our water fountains are closed and students are required to wear a mask. We have been handing out 200 plus disposable masks each week, as well as 100's of small dixie cups for student use. Please send a water bottle and a mask with your child to school to help us limit the number of disposable items being given out.

Dress for Outside:

We try to have the students go outside at recess and lunch every day. The fresh air and movement is so important for learning! Because the weather can be very wet, we are requesting that students come dressed to be outside, with coats and boots, and we strongly suggest a change of clothes to keep in their backpacks (for ALL grades).

Safety in the Parking Lot:

Our parking lot gets extremely busy in the morning and after school. Please do not parkin or leave your vehicle in the drop off lane. We would like to remind parents to talk to their kids about car safety when walking/bike riding to school and how to be safe in the parking lot. Please obey parking signs and use the designated parking spots!


Suggested items for donation to the Knights of Columbus Christmas hampers:
