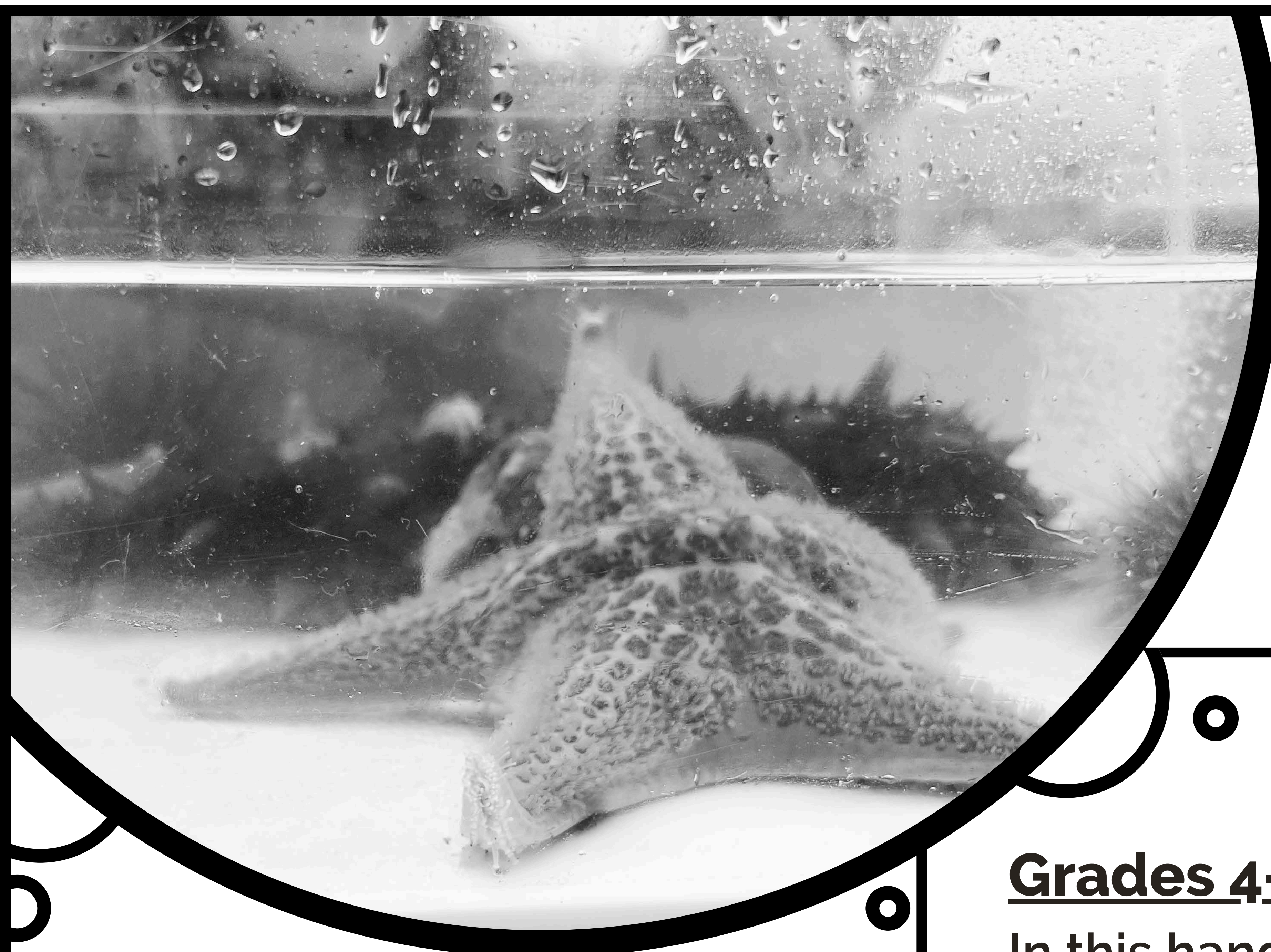


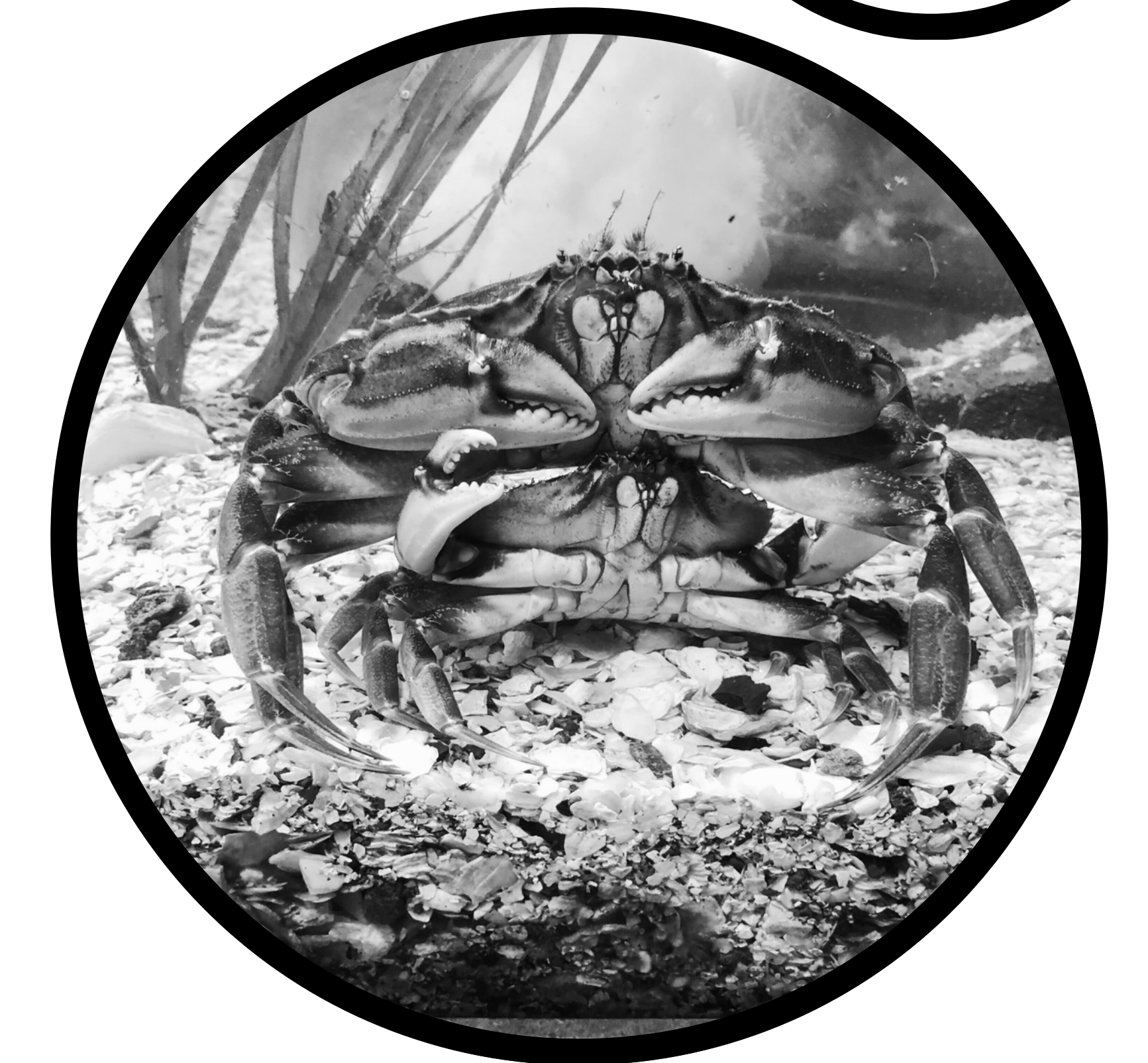

Middle School Programs

Grades 4-8: Species Exploration (90 minutes)

In this hands-on, inquiry-based program, students step into the role of marine scientists as they explore how to identify ocean animals and understand what they eat. Using tools like scientific drawing, dichotomous keys, and careful observation, students will examine a variety of sea creatures, both live and preserved, to uncover their identities and feeding habits.



The Explorer Lab is open year round for field trips.

Grades 6-8: What am I? (90 minutes)

In this program we introduce the topic of taxonomic classification using live animals and sea shells. Students will work through the identification of various local species using a dichotomous key, and will explore the various challenges of species identification
