Reflections:

Earlier today I met with the new Carihi Student Advisory Council to review the proposal for next year's timetable. This group of students have met with me to provide feedback on important items for the upcoming year, specific to their learning. In our first meeting last month, the council were enthusiastic about the idea of WIN (what individuals need) where they had voice and choice in their learning. They saw the value in this learning time offered twice a week, on double block days. This group of students have brought forth great ideas and have (thankfully) challenged some of my assumptions.

The concept of flexible learning time was reinforced last week when I stopped in to listen to grade 9 presentations. In one presentation, two students shared their rationale for including flexible learning in the weekly timetable. They recognized a need for having a say in their learning and how time is used during the school week.

As a staff we have met several times to review plans for next year. Introducing a flexible learning time for students complements the change to standards-based assessment. The goal is students focus on their learning, rather than a grade. Including flexible learning time allows students an opportunity to make decisions around their learning based on their needs.

The three goals of the 2024-28 Strategic Plan are:

Honouring Indigenous World Views and Perspectives Student Centered Learning Environments Evolving for Tomorrow

Including WIN time each week supports the Strategic Plan. It is a further commitment to student achievement through the priorities of the plan.

Other Updates:

Cell phone policy – to be included in the school code of conduct. The expectation laid out in school codes of conduct must be forwarded to the ministry in July for a September implementation.

Outdoor Cameras – are to be installed over the summer. Due to budget constraints, this may be a phased project.
