Funds may not be used for, or transferred to, curricular purposes or to schools or school districts, or any of their activities or programs.

As you can appreciate, it is very important that we are able to demonstrate that public funds are being used appropriately and for the purpose they were intended. Because of this, all recipients of Community Gaming Grants are required to report on the use of gaming funds using the



Gaming Account Summary Report (GASR). The report must be submitted to the Community Gaming Grants Branch within 90 days of the organization's fiscal year end, showing how these funds were spent. That form is available on our website at:

Failure to submit all required GASRs can impact grant funding (see Guideline 6.4).
