

Indigenous Education Council – Building Community Capacity Award

Completed application must be returned to your school counsellor **by May 9th, 2025**. Awards are sponsored by the Indigenous Education Council (IEC) for the benefit of SD72 Indigenous students. All applications are treated as confidential.

The Indigenous Education Council's vision is to have all Indigenous learners graduate with pride and confidence in who they are as individuals and who they will become. The IEC recognizes and embraces the importance of Indigenous histories, languages, values, cultures and current realities and offers financial awards to support students in their pursuit to enhance community capacity within these areas.

The Indigenous Education Council **offers 5 awards of \$2,000** each to Indigenous students who are continuing their studies at a post-secondary institution.

GENERAL

- Must be graduating from a SD72 secondary school and planning to attend a post-secondary institution such as university, college, technical or arts programs.
- Age limit: not older than 19 years by December 31, 2025.
- Awards must be used within 24 months of receiving.
- Must self-identify as having Indigenous ancestry: First Nations, Métis or Inuit.
- Include two (2) references to complete the reference form including – academic (from the school) and community (can be family, elder, knowledge keeper, community leader, etc.)
