

Installing Your Docking Station

Unbox the dock from the box. Connect the two power blocks by plugging in the “tri” male end into the “tri” female end.

THEN everything else gets plugged into the docking station.



1. Plug the power (yellow end) into the docking station.
2. Plug the Thunderbolt cord into the display port (the one with the laptop icon – red to red)
3. Plug in the HDMI monitor cord into the HDMI slot (you *may* have the Display port – double check the shape of the end of the cord that comes from your monitor).
4. Plug in your mouse and keyboard (if you have wired ones for BOTH). You may only have to plug in one *dongle* if you use a wireless mouse and keyboard.
5. Plug in the network cable (if you have one). They are *usually* yellow but could be black or green.

Plug the docking station into the wall and then make sure it is powered on by pressing the power button on the top of the dock. All other peripherals using the usb ports can now be plugged in.
