Please Etransfer or bring \$40.00 cash.

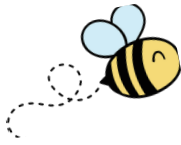
## DOGS ON SCHOOL GROUNDS

- Students in grades 3 to 5 who would like to borrow books over the summer break will only be able to do if they have brought back a permission form and their account is clear by June 15th.

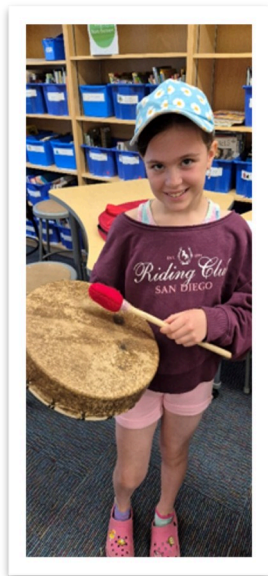

## Be Sun Smart

Too much sun exposure and especially sunburns in young children can cause eye damage and can increase the risk of skin cancer in later years. Sun damage is cumulative, which means that the damage builds up with each exposure. Those at highest risk of skin cancer are those with:

- Fair skin and blond or red hair
- Skin that burns and freckles easily and doesn't tan easily
- Lots of moles or large and unusual moles
- History of severe sunburns

The good news is that skin cancer is almost totally preventable.

From late spring to early fall, avoid unprotected sun exposure between 11:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. If your children are outdoors between these times, teach them to:

- SEEK** out the shade
- SLIP** on clothing that covers arms and legs
- SLAP** on a wide brimmed hat and sunglasses
- SLOP** on sunscreen with SPF #30 or higher
- SLURP** lots of water
