also known as National Day of Action for Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women, Girls and 2SLGBTQ+ (MMIWG). Their is the women's memorial march on **February 14th.** Another date is **August 9th** as it is International Day of the World's Indigenous Peoples which focuses on indigenous women's vital role for nurturing their culture and languages.
