Mike McInnes graduated from Carihi Secondary School in 2005 and pursued a career in the Forest Industry. Mike passed away in 2012. In honor of Mike, Holbrook Dyson Logging Company is offering an award in the amount of \$1,000 to the student who best meets the following criteria:

- Graduating in June of their grade 12 year with plans to attend Post-secondary school the following September.
- Preference will be given to a Carihi School student who has taken the Forestry program at Carihi. If a suitable candidate does not exist in this program, other students in School District 72 planning a career in Forestry may be considered.
- Consideration will also be given to students considering a career in Forestry related trades.

Applicants must write a one-page essay addressing one of the following subjects:

- The influence of the Forest Industry on the community of Campbell River
- Safety in the Forestry Industry
- The impact the Carihi Forestry Program has had on you.

Completed application forms must be turned in to your school counsellor by the last school day in April.
