Criminal Record Checks

NEW PROCEDURE

Due to the recent closure of the CR Volunteer Centre, the CR RCMP now requires a <u>school letter</u> be provided to the applicant (via email or paper copy), and they take it to the RCMP station with a completed Criminal Record Check application form. This way the applicant will only be charged the reduced rate of \$10, rather than the full \$55 fee.

We have created a form letter to be used for this purpose. If you require this letter, or the CRC form, please stop by the school office.

January 29 to February 2, 2024

Online registration (www.sd72.bc.ca) is recommended and preferred, however, if this is not an option, please contact the school office.

What you'll need:

- child's birth certificate (Canada) or proof of citizenship;
- child's Care Card;
- Proof of current residence (utility bill, purchase/rental agreement or property tax notice); and
- Custody agreement, if applicable.

Cross Catchment Transfers

Parents who would like their child to attend a different school instead of their catchment school need to submit an application for a cross catchment transfer (SD72 Form 302-1) ("CCT") by

4:00 pm on Friday, February 23, 2024

by email to student.registration@sd72.bc.ca or by uploading it as part of their online registration in MyEd

Kindergarten students MUST be registered at their catchment school BEFORE submitting an application for CCT, except for those with siblings already in attendance and who will still be in attendance in September at their requested school. In these instances, parents DO NOT need to fill out an application for a CCT verifying sibling status, but they are requested to register their child by Friday, February 2, 2024.
