An email will be sent to all Ocean Grove families just before September start-up, requesting pay-


ment and providing full details on the payment options.

Early Pick-Up of Students

2024 - 2025 Student Bus Passes

Bus pass applications for the Fall have been opened on the district website using this link: Student Transportation (sd72.bc.ca)

The **application deadline** to ensure approved ridership bus passes are available at school start-up is **June 27th**. Ensure that you are selecting the correct year in the drop-down menu.

Please do not duplicate applications. One application per child is sufficient. If you feel that you have made an error, please call the Transportation Dept.

The Transportation Dept. has noted that there have been an extraordinary amount of lost bus passes this year, so students are reminded to keep care of their passes to ensure seamless ridership throughout the school year.

The policy of MUST HAVE a bus pass to ride the school bus will be strictly enforced in the Fall, and will likely be in full effect by the end of September.
