We have new staff members this year who are passionate about being at Ocean Grove and I will introduce them in our next newsletter.

The first week of school has many emotions that go with it and families will be anxious that their child gets the best start. We will do our very best. In the first week, flexibility is the key.

On September 7th we have students put into temporary learning groups as we confirm who is returning, how many spaces we have for students waiting for placement, and observe any changes that need to be made for optimal learning. We make these decisions deliberately and carefully.

I will send out a newsletters next Friday, September 9th as well. From then on, newsletters will be sent out once a month.

First day for grades 1 thru 5 is Tuesday, September 6, 2022

Start time: 8:25 am <u>Dismissal: 10:55 am</u> (includes recess)

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If students attended Ocean Grove last year they will go to their <u>last year's classroom</u> except:

- * Mrs. Kretlow's students will meet in old classroom then move out to Portable 4;
- * Mrs. Farrell's students will meet outside old classroom then move to Room 137;
- * Mrs. Hatfield's students will meet outside old classroom then move to Room 134;

Students new to our school will be met by a staff member outside the main entrance of the school and directed to their classroom.

Please drop off your child at the exterior door of their classroom.

On Tuesday students will be taken outside for a morning break with their teacher. Please send a healthy snack with your child. Students should also come to school each day with a labelled refillable water bottle.

An email will be sent out **Tuesday, Sept. 6th** after school introducing your child to their <u>temporary LEARNING GROUP</u> teacher for this week and providing instructions regarding room location. On **Thursday, Sept. 8th** after school a "welcome email" will be sent out by your child's classroom teacher advising of their placement for this school year. Your child will go to that classroom on **Friday** morning.

Kindergarten Students:

Kindergarten begins with "gradual entry", and new kindergarten students are invited to attend for one hour on **Tuesday, Sept. 6th** between <u>11:30 to 12:30.</u> Please refer to information emailed directly to kindergarten families. If you have any questions please contact: laurasewid@sd72.bc.ca

<u>Bus students</u>: There will be two buses arriving and departing each day. New bus passes have been received for all online applications made up to and including August 26th, and will be handed out to students by teachers.
