Dressing for the WEATHER

Because we know that rain is just around the corner, we need to ensure your children dress for the weather. Here are some suggestions to help keep fun and safety the focus of our daily outside recess time at school:

- Pack an extra pair of clothes (labeled) for your child in a large plastic baggie in their backpack - shirt, pants, socks, etc. in case they get wet while playing.
- \checkmark Have your child wear a water-resistant jacket and rain pants to school to keep dry and warm.
- $\checkmark~$ Water resistant mittens or gloves are also helpful to hands remain dry and warm.
- $\sqrt{-}$ Rain boots can help keep feet dry & somewhat warm.

Breakfast is available . .


