

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Dominoes Pizza








Mother's Day Gift Supplies

At Sequoia Park they noticed the four parts to the pole, the shapes used (ovoids, split u, U forms, s forms) and we talked about different kinds of poles outside Walmart and Superstore the poles with the ancestor holding his hands down and out is a welcome pole. The one at Sequoia Park is a memorial pole that tells the family story. One child in grade five during our discussion said, "I will never look at totem poles the same way again."



School Garden

The school garden is growing beautifully and the students have been planting, weeding, and learning how to grow food! Each class has a designated box to plant their seeds in with additional boxes for blueberries, raspberries, herbs, and more. There is also a wonderful greenhouse, mason bee houses, and composters!
