BOARDING ALLOWANCE

Background

Where the School District 72 Board of Education has not provided school programs at the grade level required by students, a boarding allowance may be applied for and will be paid at a rate approved by the board as long as the student is boarding away from the family home and is attending a public school within School District 72.

Procedures

- 1. Parents or guardians wishing to be considered for boarding allowance must submit a completed application for boarding allowance form (SD72 Form 306-1) to the secretary-treasurer's office.
- 2. Applications must include a property tax notice and BC Hydro invoice, or if a BC Hydro statement is not available another utility invoice, as proof of residency for the legal guardian.
- 3. Approvals are granted for the current school year only, and for as long as the application conditions remain the same; parents or guardians must reapply for subsequent school years.
- 4. The maximum monthly boarding allowance is \$350 per student.
- 5. Parents or guardians are required to promptly notify the secretary-treasurer's office of any change in eligibility that alters the conditions of the original application for boarding allowance.

6. **Eligibility**

- 6.1 The student must not have already graduated and must not be more than 19 years of age by the end of the school year they are registered in.
- The student must be registered in a district program with a minimum of 15 in-class hours per week.
- 6.3 The legal guardian(s) for the student must be maintaining a permanent residence in the student's home community and is not renting or otherwise subletting the permanent residence.
- Sayward students attending secondary school in Campbell River are eligible for boarding allowance on an "as needed basis", to take part in co-curricular or extra-curricular activities. "As needed" shall be defined as a night following an afternoon activity, or a night preceding a morning activity. The daily rate for boarding allowance shall be 1/20th of the maximum monthly rate per student (\$17.50/day) pursuant to Ministry of Education quidelines.
- 7. Payment of a boarding allowance is dependent upon meeting the eligibility criteria outlined above and satisfactory school attendance as verified monthly by the school principal.
