

BOARD OFFICERS' EXPENSES

Background

It is the district's intent that no board officer be burdened financially for service to the school district.

Procedures

The following are authorized expenses incurred while representing the school district:

- 1. Expenses Incurred within the School District
 - 1.1 to attend committee meetings of the Board of Education;
 - 1.2 to visit schools or attend school functions;
 - 1.3 to attend conferences, seminars, workshops and professional development activities;
 - 1.4 to attend functions hosted by the Principal and Vice-Principal Association (CRPVPA), by schools, by Parent Advisory Councils, by the CRDTA and by CUPE where attendance is expected or encouraged;
- 2. Board officers shall be entitled to attend:
 - 2.1 British Columbia School Superintendents' Association (BCSSA) meetings;
 - 2.2 British Columbia Association of School Business Officials (BCASBO) meetings;
 - 2.3 British Columbia Public School Employees Association (BCPSEA) meetings and professional development seminars;
 - 2.4 Education Facility Managers Association (EFMA) meetings and professional development seminars;
 - 2.5 The meetings of any other professional organization to which the board officer belongs in a professional capacity; and
 - Other meetings related to the performance of the duties of the superintendent, assistant superintendent and secretary-treasurer.
- 3. Board officers, designated by the Board of Education, shall receive expenses:
 - 3.1 to attend BCSTA annual and special general meetings;
 - 3.2 to attend Vancouver Island School Trustees' Association meetings;
 - 3.3 to attend conferences, seminars, workshops and meetings not covered in Section 2 above.
