## ORDERING NUMBERS ACTIVITY

PURPOSE / SKILL: To build a deeper understanding of place value.
MATERIALS: 3 dice, scrap paper, a printout of the handout provided (or other recording paper)

## INSTRUCTIONS:

STEP ONE: Roll the 3 dice (or a single die 3 times).
STEP TWO: Use the three numbers on the dice to make the largest number possible.
STEP THREE: Record the number on scrap paper.
STEP FOUR: Repeat 2 more times. Now you have 3 large numbers (in the hundreds).
STEP FIVE: Write down the 3 large numbers in order from SMALLEST to LARGEST on the recording sheet.
STEP SIX: Repeat until you fill the page.

POSSIBLE NEXT STEPS: Repeat the activity using 4, 5, or 6 dice. If you do not have that many dice, it is OK! Just roll a single die 6 times.
