


Download the CRSD72 Parent App today, in either the Apple App Store or Google Play (depending on your device). The app is free!

How to Set Up the Parent App for the First Time

- 1. Open the Apple Store or Google Play (depending on whether your device is Apple IOS or Android).
- 2. Search for 'CRSD72 Parent App' in the app store, then click 'Install'.
- 3. After you download and install, open the app on your device.
- 4. Click 'Parent Login'.
- 5. Scroll to the bottom and click 'Sign Up Now'.
- 6. Enter the email address that you have on file with the school.
- 7. Enter a password. This should contain a capital letter, numbers and symbols.
- 8. Enter your preferred 'Display Name'.
- 9. Click 'Verify Code'. A verification code will be sent to your email inbox.
- 10. Enter the verification code that was emailed to you and click 'Verify Code'.

Accessing the Parent Portal Through the Internet

- 1. Open a web browser and enter 'parentportal.sd72.bc.ca'.
- 2. If you are accessing the Parent Portal for the first time and haven't already created an account through the mobile app, scroll to the bottom and click 'Sign Up Now'.
- 3. If you have already created an account through the mobile app, enter your email address and the password that you already set.
