Teachers Teaching Teachers Grant

The intention of the Teachers teaching Teachers Grant is to support teachers who host district wide workshops. This grant is provided for teachers who prepare, organize, present, and share their knowledge, understanding and learning around topics and skills relevant to teaching and learning in SD72.

Criteria:

The Core Committee awards Teachers Teaching Teachers Grants to SD72 teachers based on the following:

- The minimum number attending a workshop is six SD72 teachers and principals. This calculation does not include out of district teachers or educational assistants, although they may be in attendance. If the number of participants is less than six SD72 teachers and principals, the need for the workshop should be reassessed, the session cancelled until more interest is shown, or the grant may be pro-rated based on the number of teachers in attendance.
- Grant amounts are based on a single presenter per workshop. If the workshop is being jointly presented, the grant will be shared.
- Workshops offered during instructional time are not eligible to receive the grant.
- Principals, Vice Principals or Teachers who have positions that include an expectation of workshops and/or guided learning are not eligible to receive the grant. Please contact the Pro-D coordinator prod@sd72.bc.ca if you have questions around eligibility.
- Workshops should be pre-approved by the Pro-d coordinator so they may help with arrangements, promotion and so they may properly manage the fund.

- These workshops may take place on a Pro-D Day or as an after-school session or series.

Grant:

- \$60 per hour of workshop time
- \$1,200 maximum annual award per teacher
- For tax reasons, grants are given in the form of Pro-D credits – there is no cash value
- District Pro-D will pay Teachers Teaching Teachers credits for district-initiated events. Workshops that are hosted for school-based events should be discussed with school based Pro-D committees.
- This grant is only awarded for events that are open to educators from across the district.
