

Follow the icons below to use Stop Motion on the ipad.




Locate the Stop Motion icon on the iPad




Tap on "Plus icon" to create a New Movie

Tap on the "Grid" icon to display grid on screen for easy framing.




Frame the picture. Tap on the "shutter icon" to take the picture.




Tap on the "onion skin" icon to turn it on. This will allow you to see the previous frame.


- Adjust the opacity by moving the slider up or down.




## To export movie:
